Dear St. Vincent de Paul Parishioners, We are all aware of the concern regarding the coronavirus outbreak. So far, the COVID-19 Virus has not been reported in West Virginia, Bishop Brennan has said that at the current time he does not see the need to suspend the activities of parishes or schools nor to alter the liturgy in any way, but he is monitoring the situation closely and will make further announcements as necessary. In early January the Diocese issued the following **Guidelines for Mass Participation during the Cold and Flu Season:** *“During the cold and flu season, we ask that everyone be mindful of others when attending Mass. If you are sick and believe you are contagious, stay home. The obligation to attend Mass is not required if you are ill. If you do have cold or flu like symptoms, do not feel that you have to exchange the Sign of Peace with others. Simply wave or nod your head to your neighbors. If your parish has a custom of holding hands during the Lord’s Prayer, parishioners who are ill may fold their hands in a prayerful posture. While it is the norm in the Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston to receive the Eucharist under both sacred species, refrain from drinking from the chalice if you feel ill. You are still receiving the Body, Blood, Soul and Divinity of the Lord.”*

In addition to the above guidelines, those who serve as an Extraordinary Ministers of the Eucharist at the Liturgy are asked to use hand sanitizer prior to assisting in the Communion Rite. I pray that you have a holy and healthy Lenten Season.
