Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ,

We thank Charlie Savage and Savage Construction for reinforcing the hillside behind the church with riprap stone, and updating the system to divert the springs behind St. Vincent de Paul Church. The problem of springs on the hillside behind the church is an on-going issue.

We are moving forward with a proposal from HE Newman to replace the HVAC system for St. Vincent’s rectory. This replacement will cost a bit less than \$100,000. We considered bids from two contractors and “value-engineered” the project down to more economical cost. We must replace the rectory HVAC system because there is a risk of the existing pipes bursting and flooding the building. The Finance Council members were helpful in this project. Our Finance Council Members include Cindy Perring (chair), Lynn Hetzel, Paul Newmeyer, Derek Reed, Charlie Savage, and Matt Padden. I also thank Mr. John Reardon, the Building and Properties Supervisor for the diocese, who gave us guidance. I also thank the Finance Council of the Diocese of Wheeling Charleston for the financial gift of \$100,000 to the parish toward this project.

Although the diocese has given us a generous gift, we still need your commitment of financial stewardship toward the parish. Please support our “Missions that Matter at St. Vincent” campaign. We are postponing the work on the HVAC system at St. Vincent’s church until 2020.

This last Monday we experienced a power surge that affected our elevator, the office HVAC system, and our parish phone system. We apologize if it has been difficult to contact the office by phone this week. We also had an electrical fire in the school, which was quickly contained on Wednesday. We had to replace a breaker box at the school. Again, we thank the Diocese for a \$50,000 gift to replace the boiler at the St Vincent School.

Small Groups will be starting after the Sunday of September 15th. I will lead a small group on Wednesday evening in the parish office immediately following the 7:00 p.m. daily Mass. The first gathering of my small group will be on Wednesday, September 18th.

CATHOLIC SHARING: Our parish has received \$87,229 through 114 gifts. We are now at 37.2% of our parish goal! Our parish theme of the 2019 CSA drive is: "Missions that Matter at St. Vincent's Appeal"

Our goal is to raise \$234,585 this year to support missions that you care about. As we work toward our goal of the 2019 CSA campaign, here is how your gift will be used:

- **The Diocesan Share: \$24,585.** The Diocesan Share has been paid by the parish. Therefore, every dollar you give will be returned 100% back to the parish without any diocesan taxes.
- **Priest Salary: \$50,000** would go to paying for the salary and benefits of your current pastor.
- **Heating and Air Conditioning (HVAC): \$80,000** would maintain the heating and air-conditioning systems in the parish rectory.
- **Band: \$20,000** would pay half of the cost of our musicians at the 9:00 am celebration of our Sunday Eucharist. A generous anonymous donor pays the other half.
- **Schools: \$60,000** would be used to meet our parish obligations to Wheeling Catholic Central (\$31,000) and support St. Vincent de Paul Grade School (an additional \$19,000 to be used for tuition assistance, above our budgeted parish support) and give a modest one time bonus to the salaries of our grade school teachers (\$10,000).
