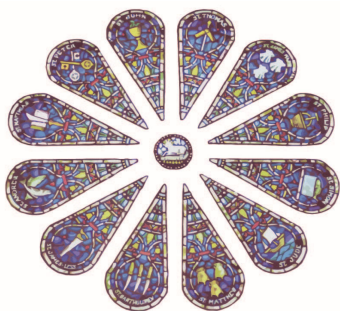

From the Pastor. . . Dear Vincent de Paul Parishioners and Friends,

In This Sunday's Gospel, we hear Jesus' words as he prepares his Apostles to go out on a mission. His words are a good primer for us as we seek to grow to be missionary disciples. Here are three points we can take away for our consideration.

Relationships are Key: *"Wherever you enter a house, stay there until you leave."* The Church is made up of relationships. Jesus' message is communicated through relationships. Jesus tells his Apostles to focus on relationships where they naturally find them (in this case, their place of lodging), and invest in those personal connections. Invest and then invite. Once we have invested in people, we can invite those same people into the life-giving message of Jesus. To whom is the Lord calling me to invest, so that I may one day be able to invite them into greater knowledge of God and greater connection with the Church?

Detachment as a sign of dependency upon the Lord: *"He instructed them to take nothing for the journey but a walking stick—no food, no sack, no money in their belts."* The spread of Gospel in the hearts of people is ultimately the work of God, not of human beings. We must do our part in the work of sharing our faith, but it is God who makes our work bear fruit. *"LORD, you establish peace for us; all that we have accomplished you have done for us."* (Isaiah 16:12) As we do the work of being Church and sharing the Good News, we must not get overly distracted by our material needs. It is vitally important that we remain people of prayer who can see past the material demands of the present moment and put our trust in God. What passing, material things distract me from the enduring spiritual work of God?

Prepare for your share of rejection: *"Whatever place does not welcome you or listen to you, leave there and shake the dust off your feet in testimony against them."* Jesus mentions the tradition of pious Jesus of shaking dust from their feet as a way to separate themselves from Gentile communities. The implication was that by shaking the dust from their feet, they were returning to holy ground. Where is your holy ground? Jesus and the community of Jesus' followers is our holy ground. In the face of any rejection we experience in this world, our Lord promised to stay with us. *"For where two or three gather together as my followers, I am there among them."* (Mathew 18:20)
