Bishop Bransfield was very gracious to visit our parish on the feast day of Pentecost and celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation. 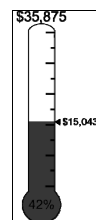

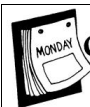
