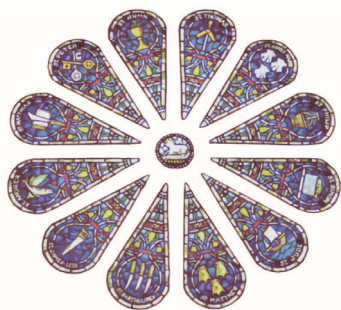

FROM THE PASTOR

Dear Parishioners:

Last Tuesday, we had a Parish Town Hall Meeting. The evening was meant to be a dialogue between the people of the parish and me, their pastor. Around 150 people were in attendance. The vast majority of attendees were parishioners of the parish, although we had a few visitors from the other local parishes. We talked about the scandals afflicting our diocese for the last year. Our conversation focused on the credible charges of harassment and abuse of adults and the charges of financial mismanagement against our former Bishop. I gave an overview of how the church has improved the response to sexual abuse crisis. Several parishioners submitted questions ahead of time, and I did my best to answer each one. I thought the conversation was frank, honest, calm and respectful. I learned a lot about what was on minds and in the hearts of the people of the parish. We ended the evening by making a list of all for which we are grateful about our local church and our faith. I thank everyone who participated. The evening was an encouragement to me and left the evening feeling inspired to serve the people of the parish well as your priest. In June, the US Bishops adopted procedures enabling the reporting of misconduct of active bishops. The Diocese of Wheeling-Charleston will contract with a company called "Ethics Point" to provide a phone hotline and internet portal, enabling a complaint to be lodged against a bishop without fear of retribution.

That is all for now.

Our parish theme of the 2019 CSA drive is:

**“Missions that Matter at St. Vincent Parish.”**

Our goal is to raise \$234,585 this year to support missions that you care about. As we work toward our goal of the 2019 CSA campaign, here is how your gift will be used:

- **The Diocesan Share: \$24,585.** The Diocesan Share has been paid by the parish. Therefore, every dollar you give will be returned 100% back to the parish without any diocesan taxes.
- **Priest Salary: \$50,000** would go to paying for the salary and benefits of your current pastor.
- **Heaters: \$80,000** would maintain the heating and air-conditioning systems in the parish rectory.
- **Band: \$20,000** would pay half of the cost of our musicians at the 9:00 am celebration of our Sunday Eucharist. A generous anonymous donor pays the other half.
- **Schools: \$60,000** would be used to meet our parish obligations to Wheeling Catholic Central (\$31,000) and support St. Vincent de Paul Grade School (an additional \$19,000 to be used for tuition assistance, above our budgeted parish support) and give a modest one time bonus to the salaries of our grade school teachers (\$10,000).

100% of the money that goes to the diocese will be used for ministry in the state of West Virginia and none of the money will be used for legal fees or settlements related to charges of sexual abuse.

## REFLECTION ON THE 14TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY



**TIME:** Jesus has a vision in this week's Gospel—Satan falling like lightning from the sky, the enemy vanquished by the missionary preaching of His Church. Sent out by Jesus to begin gathering the nations into the harvest of divine judgment (see [Isaiah 27:12-13](#); [Joel 4:13](#)), the 70 are a sign of the continuing mission of the Church.

Carrying out the work of the 70, the Church proclaims the coming of God's kingdom, offers His blessings of peace and mercy to every household on earth—"every town and place He intended to visit."

Our Lord's tone is solemn today. For in the preaching of the Church "the kingdom of God is at hand," the time of decision has come for every person. Those who do not receive His messengers will be doomed like Sodom.

But those who believe will find peace and mercy, protection and nourishment in the bosom of the Church, the Mother Zion we celebrate in this week's beautiful First Reading, the "Israel of God" Paul blesses in this week's Epistle. The Church is a new family of faith (see [Galatians 6:10](#)) in which we receive a new name that will endure forever (see [Isaiah 66:22](#)), a name written in heaven.

In this week's Psalm we sing of God's "tremendous deeds among men" throughout salvation history. But of all the works of God, none has been greater than what He has wrought by the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ. Changing the sea into dry land was but an anticipation and preparation for our passing over, for what Paul calls the "new creation." And as the exodus generation was protected in a wilderness of serpents and scorpions (see [Deuteronomy 8:15](#)), He has given His Church power now over "the full force of the Enemy." Nothing will harm us as we make our way through the wilderness of this world, awaiting the Master of the harvest, awaiting the day when all on earth will shout joyfully to the Lord, sing praise to the glory of His name.
