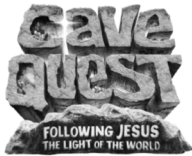

 **PARISH SCHOOL OF RELIGION:** St. Vincent de Paul Parish School of Religion (PSR) will begin Sunday, September 11 2016, from 10:45 am—12 noon, in the Marist Centre. Parents with children already participating in the PSR program should have received the registration form(s) for their children in the mail. Please return these forms NOW so that materials can be ordered and the catechists can prepare for their classes. If you have not received these forms, please call Sr. Rosella at 304-242-0406, or stop by the parish office.

All children of the parish (K-8) attending public schools should be attending the PSR program—and not just for sacramental preparation. **Special Note:** *All 1st graders attending public school must attend PSR classes in first grade in order to prepare for the sacraments of Reconciliation and First Communion in second grade.* This is Diocesan Policy.

The diocese also recommends that we have a 2 year preparation program for Confirmation. We begin the catechesis component for the Sacrament of Confirmation in 7th grade. So all 7th graders of the parish who are not attending St. Vincent School and want to be confirmed in 8th grade *must be attending PSR classes this year as 7th graders.*

In the vestibule of the church, there are copies of the PSR schedule, and also registration forms for new students.

NEEDED FOR PSR: Our Parish School of Religion is in need of a Kindergarten/First Grade Catechist. If you are interested in this important ministry of helping to lay a strong religious foundation for these children, please call the parish office at 304-242-0406. Our PSR classes begin on Sunday, September 11, and go until the end of April. We meet from 10:45 am—12 noon in the Marist Centre. Juniors and seniors in high school or college students — this is a good ministry for you to consider.
