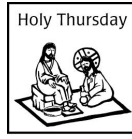

EASTER REGULATIONS—THE PASCHAL FAST:


- Fasting is to be observed on Good Friday by all Catholics who are 18 years of age but not yet 59. Those who are bound to fast may take only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to each one's needs, but eating solid food between meals is not permitted.
- All Catholics are encouraged—as a voluntary practice — to fast on Holy Saturday until the celebration of the Easter Vigil.

PASSION: The word "passion" connotes deep, focused engagement. It also relates to passivity, interestingly.

The deeply passionate person in the Gospel narrative from Luke is Jesus. He appears passive, but he is not. He is wholly self-possessed and wholly present for the one day that begins on Thursday evening at his last meal with his apostles and ends with his burial before sunset the next day. Then follows the long Sabbath silence.

The narrative of the Passion is read whole and without pause on the Palm Sunday of the Passion. This story, found in each of the Gospels, is unchanging. We are the ones who change. Each year, we bring ourselves with another year's history to hear and heed the story we so badly need.
