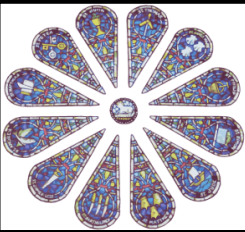

Image on the Cover

Christ Sending Out the Seventy Disciples, Two by Two (*Il les envoya deux à deux*)
from the "Life of Our Lord Jesus Christ" collection 1886-1896 - James Tissot (French, 1836-1902)

Jesus tells the seventy-two to "Go your way; behold, I am sending you out as lambs in the midst of wolves" (Luke 10:3). He wants them to learn to trust God, even though He is sending them in harm's way. Jesus wants them to be dependent upon God for their safety and provision, and so He tells them, "Carry no moneybag, no knapsack, no sandals, and greet no one on the road" (Heb 10:4). The seventy-two must not only be aware that they're going into enemy territory (Satan's world), but they must trust God with providing for their needs and not be dependent upon their own resources. We also note that Jesus told them to not get engaged in conversations along the way because they're on a mission...a great commission from Jesus Himself and He didn't want them to get distracted.

Amedisys Hospice Care located in Triadelphia, WV is currently in need of volunteers to work with our patients and their families. The Triadelphia care center serves Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, and Wetzel counties. Amedisys Hospice provides physical, emotional, and spiritual support for terminally ill patients and their families.

Volunteers are needed to provide services such as companionship to patients, respite for families and their caregivers and assisting patients with household tasks or errands. Our volunteers also aid with our Bereavement program by making supportive phone calls to family members who have lost a loved one and by helping with Support Groups. There are many ways in which volunteers can assist with our patients and families.

Volunteers must be 16 years of age and have access to transportation. The application process is simple and requires background checks, three personal references and a TB screening, which Amedisys pays for. Our volunteers also need to be vaccinated against COVID-19.
