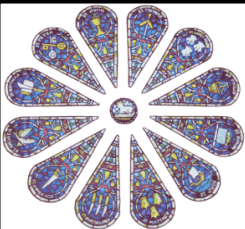
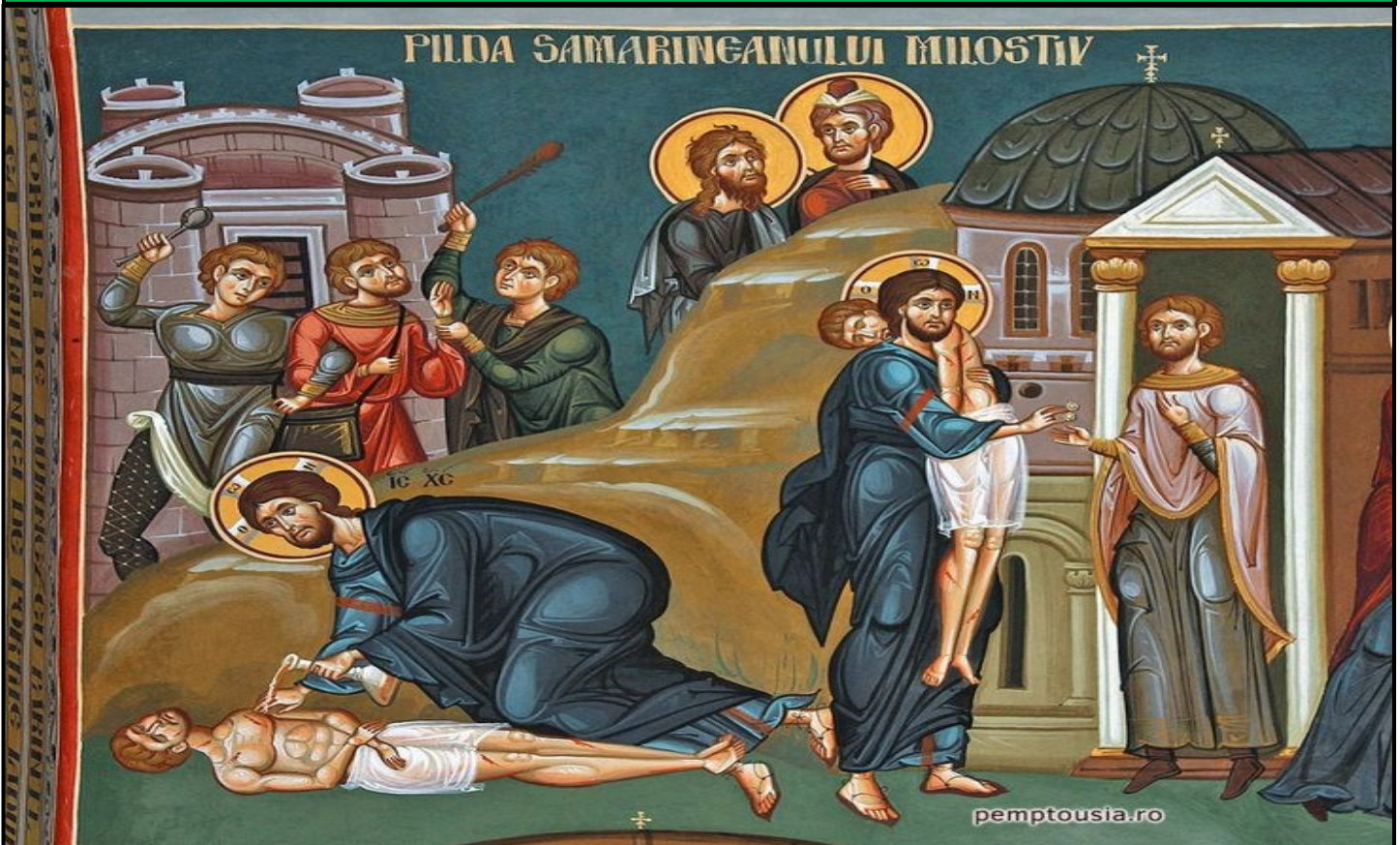

## **Image on the Cover**

***Religious Icon - Pilda Samaringanului Milostiv - (Parable of the Merciful Samaritan)***

Biblical scholars and preachers usually interpret today's Gospel passage, the parable of the Good Samaritan in one of two ways. The first is to read it as Jesus' answer to what Christian compassion, mercy, and neighborliness looks like. The scholar of the law asks Jesus, "who is my neighbor", "who should I care about" and Jesus answers: your neighbor is everyone, even the person that you would normally overlook, even the person that the rest of the world considers unclean, that's your neighbor, and you need to pick him up when he has fallen, you need to see past your preconceived notions and stereotypes and prejudices, and you need to treat him with mercy and compassion and tenderness. So that's the first interpretation.

The second way of interpreting the Good Samaritan parable is to see in this parable an allegory for what God has done for each one of us in Christ Jesus. God has raised us up when we fell upon robbers and have been "half dead" because of sin. We've been raised up, tended, cared for, restored to life because of Jesus' saving death. No human power could do what God has done for us—restoring our souls to life through baptism, healing us through grace.

- At Adoration, you can ask anything of God because He is right there. It's true, you can always ask anything of God, but you aren't always just a few feet away from Him in the form of the Blessed Sacrament.
- Each moment that you spend with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament brings God joy and pleasing worship. Adoration is one of the best ways to adore and glorify His goodness.

Amedisys Hospice Care located in Triadelphia, WV is currently in need of volunteers to work with our patients and their families. The Triadelphia care center serves Brooke, Ohio, Marshall, and Wetzel counties. Amedisys Hospice provides physical, emotional, and spiritual support for terminally ill patients and their families.

Volunteers are needed to provide services such as companionship to patients, respite for families and their caregivers and assisting patients with household tasks or errands. Our volunteers also aid with our Bereavement program by making supportive phone calls to family members who have lost a loved one and by helping with Support Groups. There are many ways in which volunteers can assist with our patients and families.

Volunteers must be 16 years of age and have access to transportation. The application process is simple and requires background checks, three personal references and a TB screening, which Amedisys pays for. Our volunteers also need to be vaccinated against COVID-19. All volunteers are trained and supervised by professional Volunteer Coordinators.

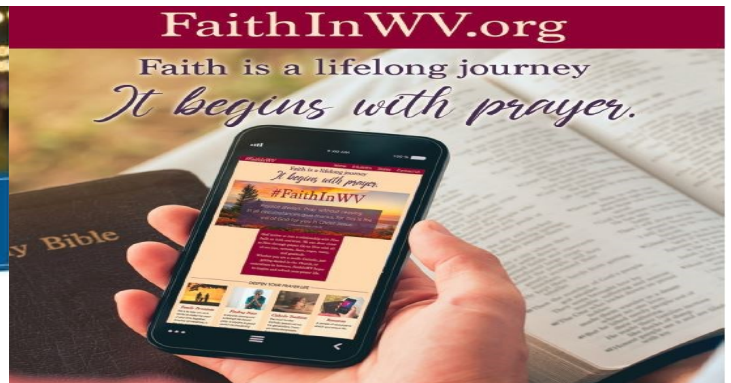

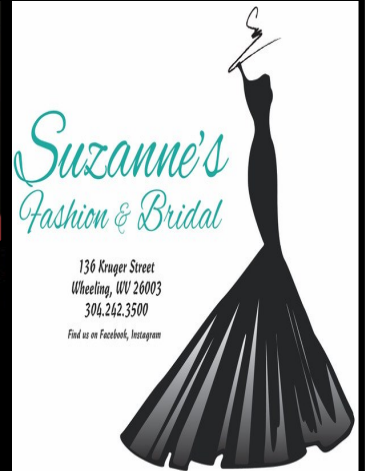

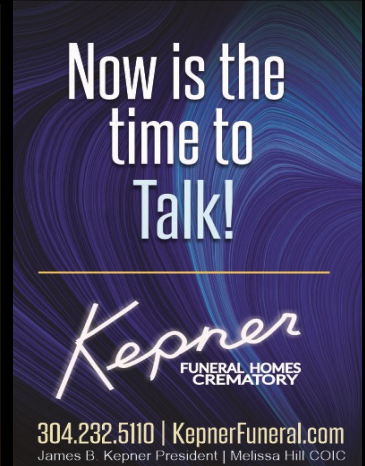
