

#### SCHOOL CLEANUP & CAMPUS BEAUTIFICATION

We have many goals for the school. I am sure you can imagine, some of those goals are related to improving the physical plant of our campus and the resources available inside it. This is no easy task and it's going to take a village.

The first step is to clean out, clean up, organize, and deep clean. Fr. Jeeson, Mr. Timberlake, and Mr. Kuhns cannot possibly do all of this alone before the start of the school year.

We are asking for your help. We need parents, families, parishioners, and staff to help us throw out unnecessary things in the building, carry and move school furniture, sort and organize, and surface clean. Once we finish our part, we will hire a cleaning service to deep clean. Jim Timberlake will then paint the hallways to complete this piece of the improvement project. We would like to have all but the painting completed by the first day of school. The painting will be completed no later than the end of the first quarter.

There will be 2 school service days before the start of the year: Thursday, August 4th, 5:30pm-8pm and Saturday, August 6th, 8am-1pm. Please consider signing up for a slot or two to help us clean up the building before the school year officially begins. #### FINANCIAL AID

Please don't forget about the upcoming FACTS deadline of August 31, 2022 in order to receive response in September 2022. This is a firm deadline and the application must be completed in full at factsmgmt.com. Click Grant & Aid Assessment, then login. All fields must be properly completed and the \$17.50 fee must be paid. In order for any form of financial aid to be awarded to any family, the FACTS application must be completed. This is a diocesan and school requirement.

As many of you know, the West Virginia Hope Scholarship has been paused. While the State Treasurer's Office is appealing the injunction, we are asking all impacted St. Vincent School Families (families who were awarded or were eligible for the WV Hope Scholarship) to please contact School Office Manager & Administrative Assistant to the Principal, Tracy Thomas to schedule an appointment with Mr. Kuhns and discuss options for moving forward.

Any other family, not impacted by the WV Hope Scholarship, seeking financial aid should complete the FACTS application as instructed above, then **email Principal Jarett Kuhns at jkuhns@stvincentschool.org**.

#### **PURIFIED EVENT**



#### **QUESTION OF THE WEEK**

#### What does Ordinary Time mean in the Catholic Church?

Because the term ordinary in English most often means something that's not special or distinctive, many people think that Ordinary Time refers to parts of the calendar of the Catholic Church that are unimportant or uninteresting. Ordinary Time is called "ordinary" because the weeks of Ordinary Time are numbered. The numbered weeks of Ordinary Time in fact, represent the ordered life of the Church. The period in which we live our lives neither in feasting, (as in Christmas or Easter seasons,) or in more severe penance, (as in Advent or Lent,) but in watchfulness and expectation of the Second coming of Christ. Thus for Catholics, Ordinary Time is the part of the year in which Christ, the Lamb of God, walks among us and transforms our lives. There is nothing "ordinary" about that. Ordinary Time refers to all of those parts of the Catholic Church's liturgical year that aren't included in the major seasons. The Church year begins with Advent, followed immediately by Christmas. Ordinary Time begins on the Monday after the first Sunday after January 6th. This period runs until Ash Wednesday when the liturgical season of Lent begins, which resumes again on the Monday after Pentecost Sunday, This second period of Ordinary Time runs until the 1st Sunday of Advent when the liturgical year begins again.
