SVS IMPLEMENTS NEW STUDENT REWARDS PROGRAM

As a school community, we believe that reinforcing positive student behavior and times when students go above and beyond is critical for the success of our educational programs. Not only do we help students gain new skills and knowledge, but we want to help them become genuinely good individuals with strong leadership skills and a moral compass. To this end, we are implementing a new Student Rewards Program.

Our new student rewards program is a modified and customized version of Positive Behavior Intervention and Supports (PBIS). PBIS is a research and evidence-based program that frames a system of supports for student's academic and school behavior journey in addition to their social, emotional, and mental health. If you are interested in learning what this means, please go to this link: <https://www.pbis.org/pbis/what-is-pbis> (there is a lot of misinformation available about PBIS, so if you are truly interested, please follow the provided link which is the gold standard of the PBIS program).

St. Vincent School is a unique community with a diverse group of learners. To accommodate a wide-variety of needs for everyone, we are implementing a tailored version of PBIS in our school. SVS will reward students for **going above and beyond** in the following areas:

***Academics *Faith *Love *Service to Others *Making a Difference *Family *Personal Growth and Achievement**

Students know what's expected of them. This program encourages all learners, at any level, to strive for excellence and achieve. When a student gets rewarded, they will receive a WARRIOR BUCK. Warrior bucks will be collected for a semester (2 grading periods) and can be spent at the school pop up store which will take place once in December and once in May. Warrior bucks will be given to students and be tracked in RenWeb.

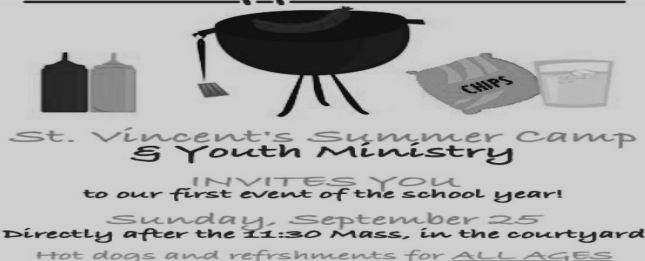

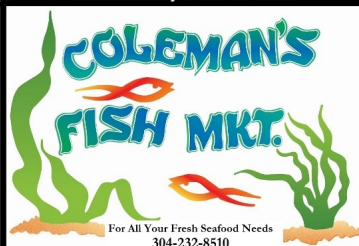
