

SVS STUDENTS ARE HIGH ACHIEVING—A MESSAGE FROM MR. KUHNS

You may have caught the great news in my letter for Giving Tuesday. St. Vincent students are high achieving! Based on Fall 2022 NWEA Map Testing results, we are happy to celebrate high achievement. SVS student population performing at the 80th percentile or higher (top 20% or better) in the nation include 12% in reading, 11% in mathematics, and 8% in language usage. Furthermore, 18% in mathematics, 15% in reading, and 10% in language usage are performing in the top 20%-40% in the nation. These are stats to celebrate and I want to extend a heartfelt congratulations to our awesome students and teachers on a job well done. 
