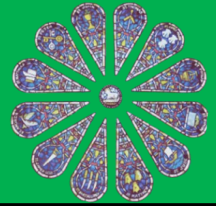

First Reading - Isaiah 6:1-2a,3-8

Overcoming Discouragement:

After he had finished speaking, he said to Simon, "Put out into deep water and lower your nets for a catch." Simon said in reply, "Master, we have worked hard all night and have caught nothing, but at your command I will lower the nets." When they had done this, they caught a great number of fish and their nets were tearing. Luke 5:4-6

Jesus had just cured Simon Peter's mother-in-law as one of His first miracles. As a result of this and other miracles, Peter's entire hometown of Capernaum, as well as many of the surrounding towns, were quickly coming to faith in Jesus. Today's Gospel takes place during this initial excitement over our Lord. In it, Jesus personally invites Peter to become an Apostle, promising to make him a fisher of men.

Reflect, today, upon the voice of God in your life. What is it that you sense Him calling you to do? What is that "deep water" to which He is calling you? As you ponder this, reflect especially upon the words of Peter, "Master...at your command I will lower the nets." Say "Yes" to the command of our Lord. Do so even if it is difficult, and especially if you do not feel like doing what He asks of you. If you do, you will find that in this act of fidelity, God will bring forth an abundance of good fruit.

FEBRUARY DEVOTIONS

By tradition, the Catholic Church dedicates each month of the year to certain devotion.

The month of February is traditionally dedicated to the Holy Family.

The special devotion which proposes the Holy Family of Jesus, Mary, and Joseph as the model of virtue of all Christian households began in the 17th century.

It started almost simultaneously in Canada and France: the Association of the Holy Family was founded in Montreal in 1663, and by the Daughters of the Holy Family in Paris in 1674.

This devotion soon spread and in 1893 Leo XIII expressed his approval of a feast under this title and himself composed part of the Office. On account of the flight into Egypt this feast has been observed by the Copts from early times.

The feast was welcomed by succeeding Pontiffs as an efficacious means for bringing home to the Christian people the example of the Holy Family at Nazareth, and by the restoration of the true spirit of family life, stemming, in some measure, the evils of present-day society.

In the words of His Holiness Pope Leo XIII, "Nothing truly can be more salutary or efficacious for Christian families to meditate upon than the example of this Holy Family, which embraces the perfection and completeness of all domestic virtues."

THEMES FOR THE 5TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C

The 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C readings highlight important themes. These themes help us understand our faith and God's call in our lives.

God's Holiness: Isaiah's vision shows God's holiness. The seraphim praise God, reminding us of His greatness and our need to honor Him.

Human Unworthiness: Isaiah feels unworthy before God. This teaches us humility and the need for God's forgiveness.

God's Call: Isaiah answers God's call, saying, "Here I am, send me." This shows that we should be ready to respond to God's call in our lives.

Witnessing to Faith: Paul reminds the Corinthians of the gospel he preached. This shows the importance of sharing our faith with others.

God's Grace: Paul speaks of God's grace working in him. This reminds us that any good we do is by God's help.

Following Jesus: In the Gospel, Jesus calls Peter, James, and John to follow Him. This teaches us to trust Jesus and follow His lead.

These themes from the 5th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C guide us in our faith journey. They remind us of God's greatness, our call to serve, and the need to trust and follow Jesus.

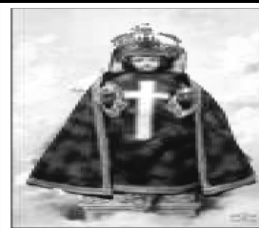
MARIST THIRD ORDER OF MARY

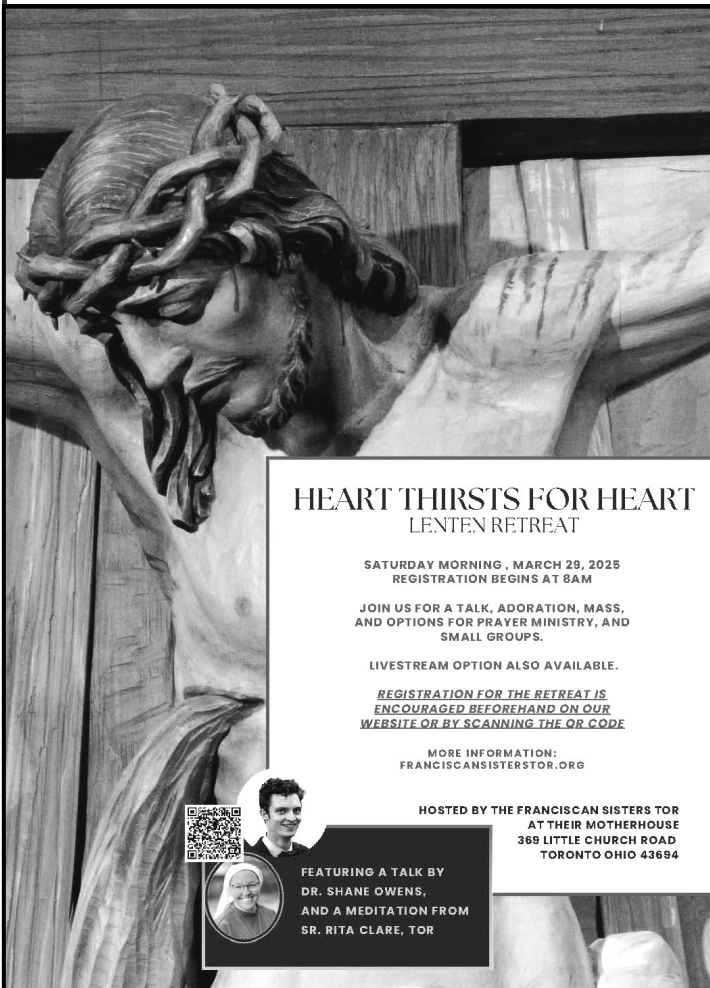

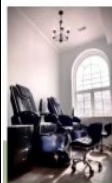
