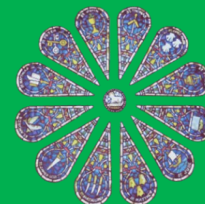

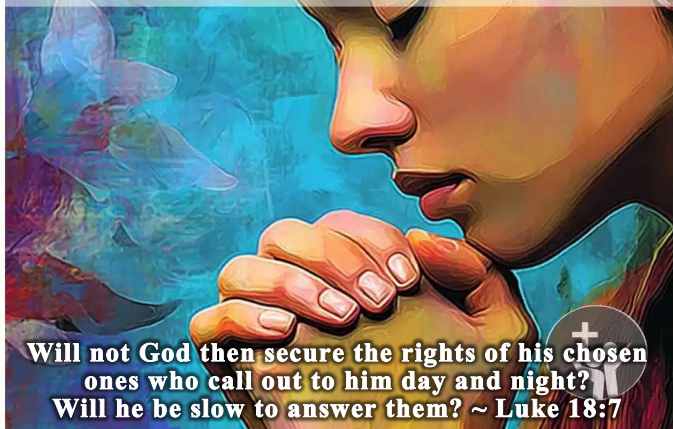

# 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C



Will not God then secure the rights of his chosen ones who call out to him day and night?  
Will he be slow to answer them? ~ Luke 18:7

### First Reading - Exodus 17:8-13

Amalek attacked Israel. While Joshua fought, Moses stood on a hill with God's staff. As long as Moses' hands were raised, Israel prevailed. Aaron and Hur supported Moses' hands, and Joshua defeated Amalek.

### Responsorial Psalm - Psalm 121:1-2, 3-4, 5-6, 7-8

Our help comes from the Lord, who made heaven and earth. He guards us constantly, protects us from harm, and watches over us always.

### Second Reading - 2 Timothy 3:14-4:2

Stay faithful to the Scriptures, which provide wisdom for salvation. All Scripture is inspired by God and useful for teaching and training. Proclaim the word persistently, with patience and encouragement.

### Gospel Acclamation - Hebrews 4:12

The word of God is living and effective, discerning reflections and thoughts of the heart.

### Gospel Reading - Luke 18:1-8

Jesus told a parable about a persistent widow to teach the importance of constant prayer. If an unjust judge grants justice, how much more will God respond to his chosen ones?

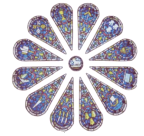

#### Justice Through Mercy:

*Jesus told his disciples a parable about the necessity for them to pray always without becoming weary. Luke 18:1*

In our parable for today, we have the witness of a widow who came to a dishonest judge and continuously begged him for a just judgment. Though the judge did not care about the woman, he eventually rendered a just decision for her because she was so persistent. It's interesting that Jesus used the image of a "dishonest judge" to teach us about persistent prayers being answered. He does so because He wants us to understand that if even those who are dishonest respond to persistence, then so much more will the Just Judge of Heaven respond to persistence.

Reflect, today, upon anything for which you desire justice. Is there anything that has been unfair in your life? Do you dwell upon any hurt inflicted upon you by another? As you call those things to mind, know that the power of your persistent prayer has the potential to transform those sufferings into God's mercy. Beg for this gift and know that God will always answer those prayers.

**Most just Judge,**  
*You desire to transform every injustice into mercy by calling us to freely embrace those injustices out of love.*  
**This is a high calling, dear Lord,**  
*but it is also a glorious one.*  
**Please give me the grace I need to follow Your example and to persevere in this form of prayer always.**  
**Jesus, I trust in You.**

### THEMES FOR THE 29TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C

The 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C offers insights into perseverance, prayer, and the strength found in faith. The readings emphasize the importance of trusting in God and being persistent in our spiritual life.

**Persistence in Prayer:** The Gospel of Luke shows Jesus encouraging persistent prayer through the parable of the unjust judge and the widow. This teaches that we should keep praying even when it seems difficult.

**Support in Community:** In Exodus, Moses is supported by Aaron and Hur to keep his hands raised, symbolizing the power of community support. It reminds us that we need each other to sustain our faith.

**Faithful Endurance:** The second reading from 2 Timothy emphasizes staying true to what we have learned and believed. It encourages us to endure hardships and be faithful to the teachings of Christ.

**Justice and Trust:** The parable in the Gospel highlights the importance of seeking justice and trusting that God hears our prayers. Even when answers seem delayed, we should trust in God's timing.

**Role of Scripture:** Paul in 2 Timothy speaks about the importance of scripture in teaching and guiding believers. This reminds us of the value of the Bible in our daily lives and decision-making.

**Power of Intercession:** The scene in Exodus, where Moses prays with uplifted hands, illustrates the power of intercessory prayer. It shows how praying for others can bring about God's help and support.

The readings for the 29th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C remind us to be steadfast in our faith and persistent in prayer. They encourage us to trust in God's timing and the strength found in community and scripture.

### SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM PRAYING FOR THE UNBORN AND THEIR FAMILIES

Starting in October (Pro-Life Month), the I am asking you and your family to do something very simple, yet Very Powerful. We are asking you all to promise to pray daily for 9 months a baby who might not otherwise make it to birth. This was the idea of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen and is called Spiritual Adoption. Our focus will be on the Power of Prayer to help babies and their families.

The prayer may be prayed in the morning, in the evening, or whenever it is convenient for you and your family. Please also give a name to the baby for whom you are praying to make it more personal. You may not know who this baby is, but God does, and I'm sure you will one day meet in heaven. You can do this individually, or this would be great to do as a family.

Many parents have experienced the loss of a child before birth, due to a miscarriage, or an abortion. We are asking you to pray a child to birth ~ asking God for the health and safety of the baby, and to give the parents of these children the grace they need to face whatever difficult circumstances in which they may find themselves.

#### **This is the Spiritual Adoption Prayer to pray daily:**

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much.  
I beg you to protect the baby in its mother's womb, especially \_\_\_\_\_,  
whom I have spiritually adopted.

Please give the parents of this child the help they need to keep their baby strong and healthy. Amen.

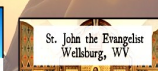
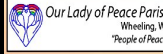
