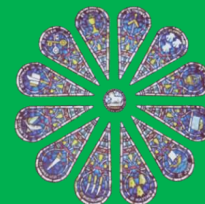

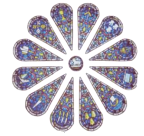

The Twenty-seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time - Sunday, October 5th, 2025

The 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C speaks about faith, trust, and serving others. Faith does not need to be big to be real. Even a little faith, if it is true, can do great things. Faith grows when we trust God, even when life feels unfair or hard. It means waiting for God's plan and believing He is working, even if we cannot see it yet.

This Sunday also speaks about using the gifts God has given us. Each person has something to offer, and we should use these gifts to help others. Serving God is not about seeking praise or rewards. It is about doing what is right because it is what God asks of us. Faith and service belong together. When we trust God and serve with love, we show our faith in simple, everyday ways.

Most glorious Lord, Increase my faith.

Give me a pure faith—a faith that enables You to lead me down the unknown path to Your glory.

With this gift of faith, please use me to bring forth Your miraculous power by which sin is uprooted and souls are nourished by You alone.

Jesus, I trust in You.

Nourished by Faith:

The apostles said to the Lord, "Increase our faith." The Lord replied, "If you have faith the size of a mustard seed, you would say to this mulberry tree, 'Be uprooted and planted in the sea,' and it would obey you." Luke 17:5-6

Is it possible to completely uproot a tree and plant it in the sea? It's certainly hard to imagine how. It is especially hard to imagine doing so with a simple command of faith. Uprooting a tree is hard enough to imagine, but it is even more difficult to imagine a tree being planted in the sea. Though water is necessary, one cannot plant a tree in the sea and expect it to grow. But that's partly the point. We often underestimate the power of true faith. Saint Matthew's Gospel says that faith can move mountains. Saint Luke's says it can uproot a tree and replant it in the sea. All it takes to do so is faith the size of a mustard seed.

Reflect, today, upon the prayer of the apostles: "Increase our faith." Some of the greatest mystics taught that faith darkens the intellect. By this darkening, they mean that, by faith, God will lead us into the unknown, on a path that He alone is aware of. We will become instruments of His transforming grace in ways that are completely beyond our natural abilities. Pray for an increase of faith. When our Lord hears your humble prayer, by which you also confess your lack of faith, He will increase that faith, uproot sin and evil, and plant your soul in places in which you become nourished in ways that you could have never imagined possible.

THEMES FOR THE 27TH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME YEAR C

The 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C offers us various lessons through its readings. Each reading provides insights into how we live and believe as Christians.

Living by Faith: The prophet Habakkuk questions God about the suffering he sees. God responds by telling him to wait for a vision that promises justice. This teaches us that faith involves trusting God's timing and plan, even when we don't understand.

Gift of the Spirit: In the second reading, Paul encourages Timothy to use the gifts God has given him. This reminds us that God equips us with spiritual gifts, and we should use them boldly and lovingly.

Power of Small Faith: Jesus mentions that faith as small as a mustard seed can do great things. It shows us that the size of our faith is less important than its true presence and action in our lives.

Duty and Service: The Gospel also compares faith to a servant doing his duty. It teaches us that following Jesus means serving without expecting rewards; our actions are part of our Christian duty.

Vision and Persistence: Habakkuk is told to write down a vision clearly. This tells us that having a clear vision and persistence in faith can guide us through challenges and uncertainties.

Courage in Witnessing: Paul's words to Timothy highlight the need for courage in proclaiming our faith. This encourages us to be strong and persistent in sharing our belief with others.

These themes from the 27th Sunday in Ordinary Time Year C encourage us to reflect on our faith and duties as Christians. They guide us in living out our beliefs in practical and faithful ways.

SPIRITUAL ADOPTION PROGRAM PRAYING FOR THE UNBORN AND THEIR FAMILIES

Starting in October (Pro-Life Month), the I am asking you and your family to do something very simple, yet Very Powerful. We are asking you all to promise to pray daily for 9 months a baby who might not otherwise make it to birth. This was the idea of Archbishop Fulton J. Sheen and is called Spiritual Adoption. Our focus will be on the Power of Prayer to help babies and their families.

The prayer may be prayed in the morning, in the evening, or whenever it is convenient for you and your family. Please also give a name to the baby for whom you are praying to make it more personal. You may not know who this baby is, but God does, and I'm sure you will one day meet in heaven. You can do this individually, or this would be great to do as a family.

Many parents have experienced the loss of a child before birth, due to a miscarriage, or an abortion. We are asking you to pray a child to birth ~ asking God for the health and safety of the baby, and to give the parents of these children the grace they need to face whatever difficult circumstances in which they may find themselves.

This is the Spiritual Adoption Prayer to pray daily:

Jesus, Mary and Joseph, I love you very much.

I beg you to protect the baby in its mother's womb, especially _____, whom I have spiritually adopted.

Please give the parents of this child the help they need to keep their baby strong and healthy. Amen.
