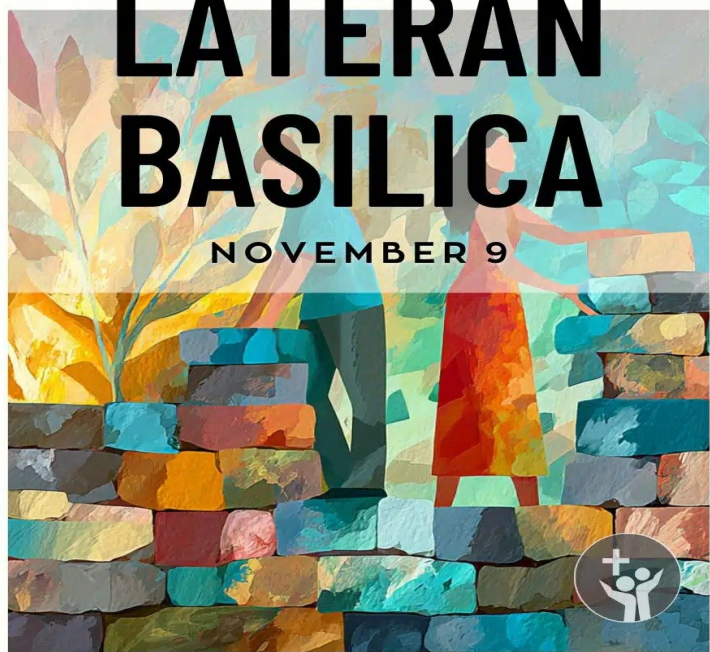

### **First Reading** - Ezekiel 47:1-2, 8-9, 12

From the temple, water flows eastward, bringing life and freshness to everything it touches, with fruit trees along its banks providing food and healing.

### **Responsorial Psalm** - Psalm 46:2-3, 5-6, 8-9

God is our unshakable refuge and strength, securing the city He dwells in. His presence assures protection and peace, even amidst turmoil.

### **Second Reading** - 1 Corinthians 3:9c-11, 16-17

We are God's building, with Jesus as the foundation. Each must build carefully, for we are temples of the Holy Spirit, sacred and protected by God.

### **Gospel Acclamation** - 2 Chronicles 7:16

### **Gospel Reading** - John 2:13-22

Near Passover, Jesus visits the Jerusalem temple, expelling merchants and overturning money-changers' tables, condemning the commercialization of the sacred space. Challenged by the Jews for a sign to justify his actions, he cryptically mentions rebuilding the temple in three days, a reference to his resurrection understood later by his disciples.

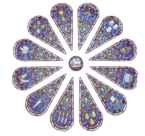

We celebrate, today, the Lateran Basilica in Rome, the mother church of the entire Roman Catholic Church. It was given to the Bishop of Rome in the fourth century and remained the pope's primary residence until the building of St. Peter's Basilica, at a time when the Lateran Basilica was falling into ruins. However, the Lateran Basilica to this day remains the most important Church in the world, since it is officially the Cathedral Church of Rome.

As we honor this church, we honor more than a building. The Lateran Basilica is a symbol of the one true Church of Jesus Christ. Its interior is beautiful and awe-inspiring so as to point us to the unimaginable beauty of the Church Herself, which is the Mystical Body of Christ.

Reflect, today, upon this powerful image of Jesus cleansing the Temple. As you do, apply it to your own life. The people selling and buying in the Temple must have been shocked at Jesus' zeal and actions. If you have become complacent with your sins, try to allow this holy shock to also wake you up. Allow our Lord's zeal to affect you, and know that His purifying actions are acts of love by which He desires to free you to become a more fully functioning member of His holy Church.

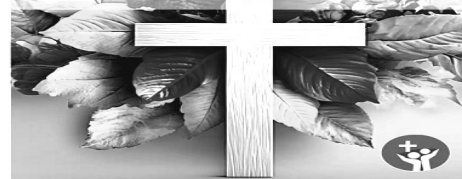

## FAQ - ABOUT THE FEAST OF THE DEDICATION OF THE LATERAN BASILICA IN ROME

### What date is Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica in Rome?

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica is celebrated annually on November 9th. This date marks the anniversary of the dedication of the Basilica by Pope Sylvester I in the 4th century.

### What is the significance of the Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica?

The Feast of the Dedication of the Lateran Basilica commemorates the dedication of the cathedral church of Rome, known as the Lateran Basilica. This feast is significant because the Lateran Basilica is the oldest and ranks first among the four Papal Basilicas of Rome, making it a symbol of unity in the Catholic Church.

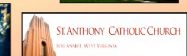
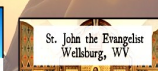
