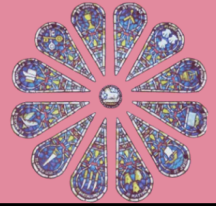

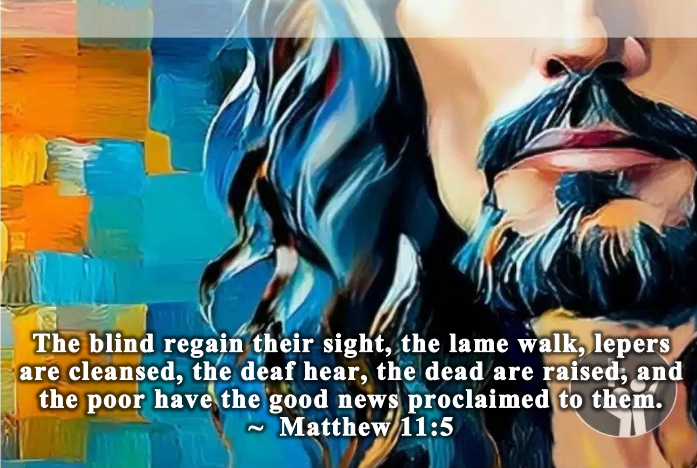

## 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT YEAR A



The blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them.  
~ Matthew 11:5

### First Reading - Isaiah 35:1-6a, 10

The desert will bloom and rejoice. God will strengthen the weak and bring justice. The blind will see, the deaf will hear, and the saved will enter Zion with joy.

### Responsorial Psalm - Psalm 146:6-7, 8-9, 9-10.

The Lord is faithful, brings justice, feeds the hungry, frees captives, and gives sight to the blind. He supports the fatherless and widows, and reigns forever.

### Second Reading - James 5:7-10

Be patient for the Lord's coming, like a farmer waiting for crops. Strengthen your hearts, avoid complaining, and follow the example of patient prophets.

### Gospel Acclamation - Isaiah 61:1 (cited in Lk 4:18)

The Spirit of the Lord is upon me, because he has anointed me to bring glad tidings to the poor.

### Gospel Reading - Matthew 11:2-11

John the Baptist sent his disciples to ask Jesus if he was the one to come. Jesus affirmed his works. He praised John as the greatest prophet, yet less than the least in heaven.

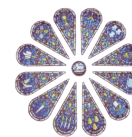

## Liturgy and Minister Schedule

### The Third Sunday of Advent - Gaudete Sunday, December 14th, 2025

The 3rd Sunday of Advent, called Gaudete Sunday, is a time to rejoice. Even as we wait for Jesus, we can find joy in knowing He is near. Isaiah tells us that the desert will bloom and the weak will find strength. James reminds us to be patient and trust in God's timing. Jesus shows that God's promises are being fulfilled through His works.

This Sunday encourages us to stay hopeful. Joy does not come from perfect circumstances but from God's presence among us. We are called to look for signs of His goodness and to wait with faith. Our joy grows as we remember that Jesus brings healing, peace, and new life to the world.

#### *My sacrificial Lord,*

*You invite me to take no offense at Your suffering and death;  
to see beyond the pain, blood, and physical death;  
and to discover the unfathomable riches of Your Sacrifice.*

*Please give me the eyes of faith to see the value of not only accepting Your Cross, but also to see the value of living Your Passion in my own life by laying down my life with You.*

*Jesus, I trust in You.*

#### Rejoicing in the Cross:

*“Go and tell John what you hear and see: the blind regain their sight, the lame walk, lepers are cleansed, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the poor have the good news proclaimed to them. And blessed is the one who takes no offense at me.” ~ Matthew 11:4-6*

Suppose a priest came to your church to put on a parish mission, and during that mission he miraculously healed the blind, crippled, terminally ill, and deaf. What if he even raised the dead to life? How would you respond? Most likely with amazement! You'd contact everyone close to you and tell them about those miracles, encouraging them to attend the next session.

Though Jesus' ministry was filled with miracles, they were far from the most important part of His mission. His miracles healed bodies that would eventually die, but His preaching healed souls that would live forever because His preaching ultimately pointed to His greatest work—to suffer and die for the salvation of souls.

Reflect today on these questions within the context of your own life. When you pray, do you primarily ask for favors, blessings, or miracles? Or do you primarily pray for the Cross? Do you see greater value in having God remove some suffering from your life or in transforming your suffering by the power of His Cross? Ask for the grace to die with our Lord, to become a living sacrifice of love, and to have the strength to lay down your life for others. By choosing that which has eternal value, you choose the better part and will rejoice in that better part forever.

### THEMES FOR THE 3RD SUNDAY OF ADVENT, YEAR A – GAUDETE SUNDAY

Gaudete Sunday, the 3rd Sunday of Advent Year A, is a time of joyful anticipation. The readings focus on hope, patience, and recognizing God's presence among us.

**Joy in God's Promise:** The readings show that God's promise brings joy. Isaiah speaks of the desert blooming, and Jesus points to His works as signs of God's presence.

**Patience in Waiting:** James calls for patience as we wait for the Lord. Like a farmer waiting for crops, we must trust that God's timing is perfect.

**Hope for Healing:** Isaiah promises healing for the blind, the deaf, and the lame. Jesus' miracles in the Gospel show that He fulfills this promise.

**The Lord is Near:** The nearness of God brings hope. Jesus reminds John's disciples that He is the one they are waiting for.

**Signs of the Messiah:** Jesus points to His works as signs of the Messiah. The miracles He performs fulfill the prophecies in Isaiah.

**Encouragement in Trials:** James encourages us to stay strong through challenges. Like the prophets, we are called to endure with hope and patience.

Gaudete Sunday reminds us that our waiting is filled with joy and hope. As we prepare for Christ's coming, we trust in God's promises and His perfect timing.

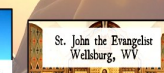
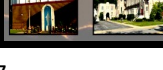

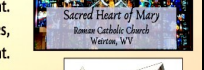
